



WRITING FOR PUBLICATION

An Eight-Week Class with Teresa Jordan

Starts Tuesday, February 17, in Salt Lake City

The purpose of this workshop is to help already-published writers increase their success and help those who have never published before work toward their first magazine or journal acceptance. This is a workshop for serious writers: you will be expected to develop an idea, submit it to an editor, and follow through writing the article or revising the idea for resubmission.

We will focus on what makes good magazine writing: how to hook the reader; how to develop the story; how to make the writing sing. And we will also work on the nuts and bolts of publishing: how to focus an idea; how to identify the right publication for it; how to write a query; how to work with an editor; how to revise.

This workshop reaches out of the classroom and into the real world. Nearly a dozen local and regional editors have agreed to respond to queries from class members within a week, so you will have a unique chance to respond to editorial acceptance or rejection, supported by the advice and support of the class. At least two editors will visit the class, so you can ask questions and experience first-hand how editors think.

The publications that have signed on so far cover a wide range of interests and include: *Wasatch Journal*; *Salt Lake Magazine*; *Utah CEO*; *Catalyst*; *Wasatch Woman*; *High Desert Journal*; *Sojourns*; *Cycling Utah*; *High Country News*; and the syndicate, *Writers on the Range*.

Teresa Jordan is the author or editor of seven books, including the memoir, *Riding the White Horse Home*. She has taught writing at workshops, colleges and universities in several Western states.

Class Size: Limited to 12

Duration: Eight weeks, February 17 – April 14, (There will be no class Tuesday, April 7)

When: Tuesday nights, 6:30 p.m. – 9:30 p.m.

Where: Near the University of Utah
